1 Introduction

Proceedings concerning the board, committees and fraternities are recorded in the rules and regulations and/or the by-laws of *Study association Sticky*. We are always expecting that people follow the regulations of Utrecht University and the laws of the Dutch state.

2 General guidelines

- At no moment we will tolerate any racism, discrimination and intimidation based on gender, race, sexual orientation, appearance, language or any other form.
- In any case that you as a member are feeling unconformable, bullied or feel marginalised, please take contact with the counsellors or the board of *Study association Sticky*.
- Alcohol consumption on the university campus is allowed starting from 17:00. Excessive alcohol consumption is not allowed, so drink responsibly.
- In case of emergency, always follow the directions of the present board members or emergency response officers.

• Always respect each others privacy. If a member does not consent to taking photo or video material, please stop and remove any media that contains this person.

3 Study association Sticky activities

- At no time during *Study association Sticky* related events is drug use allowed. This concerns any and all soft and hard drugs for recreational purposes. This does not include alcohol.
- If a board or committee member is giving instructions related to the activity, you will have to follow them at all times.
- You are expected to clean up after yourself during any and all (external) activities.
- During job market orientation and educational related activities, you are expected to be professionally composed and show no weird behaviour.

4 Study association Sticky trips

- During a trip from *Study association Sticky*, there will always be a given departure time. You are obligated to be present during the given time at the given location. If you are not on time, you are no longer allowed to join.
- During your stay abroad, you are expected to follow the laws, rules and manners which are applicable at the location.
